In 1858 a fourteen-year-old girl named Bernadette Soubirous witnessed the first of eighteen visions of the Blessed Virgin Mary at a grotto near Lourdes, France. Millions of people have since made a pilgrimage to Lourdes. They are drawn by their faith in the miraculous cures attributed to the waters flowing from a spring to which Bernadette was directed by the Blessed Virgin. Our Parish was established on May 2, 1962 under the title of Our Lady of Lourdes.

Those gathering in **Our Lady of Grace this Sunday** will be celebrating the Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time.

Each year people gather together on this day - known as **World Day of the Sick** - to pray for the sick.

WORLD DAY OF THE SICK TODAY

World Day of the Sick was first observed on February 11, 1993, as a global event when people remember or pray for the sick. Started by Saint John Paul II as a way for believers to offer prayers for those suffering from illnesses, people around the world take the time to pray on this day for the sick and for those who work very hard to alleviate the sufferings of the sick.

The **theme** for this year's World Day of the Sick, proclaimed by Pope Francis, is provided by the words that Jesus spoke from the cross to Mary, his mother, and to John: "Woman, behold your son...Behold your mother. And from that hour the disciple took her into his home." (John 19:26-27). This day coincides, very appropriately, with the commemoration of Our Lady of Lourdes.
